David Parker Tells Why He Was Arrested

“I, David Parker, am the father of a kindergarten student at Estabrook Elementary School in Lexington, Massachusetts. At the beginning of this school year, my wife and I learned that our children were being exposed to discussions about gay households and same-sex unions. There are definite plans to increase the teacher-student discussions of these subjects.

We have officially stated on many occasions—to the Lexington school administration— our request that we wanted to be notified when these discussions were planned, and we wanted our six-year-old to be excused from such situations.”

Our parental requests for our own child were flat-out denied, with no effort at accommodation. In our meeting on April 27, I insisted that such accommodation be made, and I refused to leave the meeting room. I was informed that I would be arrested.”
